Proscan and Motivation Reviews: Finding the Why

If you are in our Blue Ocean program then chances are that you have spent some time talking to Grace or Linda about what motivates you. This month we wanted to share some insight into the Proscan and motivation review process and how it is a benefit to our students. The Know Your Talents team took a minute to answer some common questions that students have when they are beginning the process.

What can a student expect to happen once they receive their

Proscan link? The survey in the Proscan link takes 5 to 10 minutes to complete. We suggest answering the questions as quickly as possible to get the best results. Once we have the results we review them with the student. The Proscan review is always fun because it focuses on what's great about the student, what they are good at, how they like to be motivated, and how to understand that behavior. After the initial review of the Proscan we do a Motivation review, which is an in-depth view of their personality and motivators.

What are students generally surprised or excited to learn about themselves when you review the results of their Proscan?

They are most surprised that not everyone feels the same as they do or has the same motivator. For instance, people with high extroversion are always surprised that those with low extroversion don't really care for recognition and they don't enjoy team meetings like they do - and vice versa.

How is learning about your behavior beneficial to a student's success in the Blue Ocean program?
