What is a ProScan?

As some of you may recall or are currently going through the process, you have experienced the PDP ProScan Behavioral Survey. So, what is it exactly?

The ProScan (PS) is a self-awareness instrument that aids in developing better communications, understanding, and mutual respect. PDP focuses on the **strengths** of individuals and has proven that when **strengths** are understood and matched with the requirements of a job or situation, positive improvements will result. In other words, it helps us understand the way you function most **naturally and efficiently**.

Why is it important?

LearnKey uses the Proscan to better serve our students. Not only does it help us understand everyone's natural strengths but it also helps us communicate more effectively, motivate using the right tools, and optimize the career search upon completion of the program.

Many times, a job can be incredibly draining, zero motivation to go to work, and even less motivation to complete the tasks assigned. But we do it anyway, with low satisfaction. What if we can avoid even putting ourselves in that situation or finding out what adaptations we need to make before we start a job?
